The collection will be assigned ISBN and placed in the bibliographic database “Russian Science Citation Index” at <http://elibrary.ru>. Each participant of the conference will receive a certificate.

The conference working languages are **Russian and English**.

Requirements for paper submission

Application forms and papers are to be submitted electronically as separate files:

The file name for an application form should contain full name of the author and the word “Application”, e.g., «Julie Nesterova. Application»; each author of the same presentation / paper has to submit a separate application form;

The file name for a paper should contain full name of the author and the word “paper”, e.g., «Leslie Cardow. Paper».

Authors are encouraged to make a thorough check of their papers in terms of the content and compliance with submission requirements.

Originality of texts should be no less than 75 %.

Authors are responsible for the content and layout of their papers.

The conference organizing committee may return submitted papers to authors for revision to reach full compliance with submission requirements.

Publication requirements

Applications and **papers** for participation in the conference are to be submitted by email tver.genconference2019@gmail.com The submission deadline is *April 30, 2019*.

Papers should be limited to maximum 5 pages. Submission requirements are listed in **Appendix 1**.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

✂ Paper layout:

- ***In Russian (if appropriate):*** paper title (text-align: center, bold, small letters), full name of the author(s), job title, research degree, academic rank, educational organization, city, country (text-align: left, italics); abstract (4-6 lines, text-align: justify); keywords (maximum 10, text-align: justify);
- ***In English:*** paper title (text-align: center, bold, small letters), full name of the author(s), job title, research degree, academic rank, educational organization, city, country (text-align: left, italics); abstract (4-6 lines, text-align: justify); keywords (maximum 10, text-align: justify);
- ***text:*** in Russian or English up to 5 pages; originality of the text should be no less than 75%, authors are liable for plagiarism;
- ***list of references:*** all references are to be put in square brackets designating page numbers for citations and quotes referred to by the author, e.g. [1, p. 34-35]. Sequence of references should be separated by semicolon, e.g. [1, p. 34-35; 3, z. 45]. The list of references has to be in the end of the main body of the paper containing the actually mentioned references in the alphabetical order.

✂ Layout:

- font 14 pt, TimesNewRoman, single space;
- font (character spacing): scale 100%, normal interval, no displacement;
- all margins 2 cm, automatic word-break forbidden, indentation 1,25 cm., spacing between paragraphs «Before»/ «After» – 0 pt;
- all tables should be added in the textual order, subject headings to be placed above the tables. Table numeration has to be right-justified (Table 1), the table heading is printed on the new line, text-align: center;
- all pictures are to have relevant headings and be placed in the textual order. Headings and numbers of pictures should be printed under the pictures, text-align: center (Picture 1. Heading);
- font for tables, pictures and relevant inscriptions is 12 pt. All tables, schemes, pictures, formulas, graphs etc. should not exceed the above-mentioned margins. Scanned texts, formulas, pictures and tables are not accepted for publication;
- template of the bibliographic description of a book: *Yurevich A.V. Social psychology of scientific activities. – M.: Institute of Psychology of the Russian Academy of Sciences, 2013. – 447 p.;*
